

CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY INTO NIGER REPUBLIC

The auto or self-isolation will no longer be necessary for the travelers entering the Niger republic with:

***A negative PCR test of 5 days for the countries of West African Economic and Monetary Union (WAEMU), which are: Benin, Burkina Fasso, Cote d Ivoire, Guinea Bissau, Mali, Niger, Senegal and Togo.**

***A negative PCR test of 72 hours from the date the sample was collected, fully vaccinated, where the last dose or the single unique dose was taken at least for the past 4 weeks, for other countries.**

2-The 7 days' self-isolation remains in force if the traveler does not hold a five days negative PCR test, for the WAEMU countries.

Or a negative PCR test of at least 72 hours from the date the sample was collected for other countries and not being fully vaccinated, where the last dose or unique dose was taken at least for the past 4 weeks.

Such a traveler will observe the 7 day's self-isolation. Thereafter, they will conduct a free of charge of covid-19 test in an appropriate center approved by the Minister of Health.
